Law n° 2011-5 dated 9 February 2011, entitling the President of the Republic by interim to issue decrees-laws in accordance with article 28 of the constitution (1).

In the name of the People,

The Chamber of Deputies and the Chamber of Advisors having adopted,

The President of the Republic by interim enacts the following law:

Article one - In accordance with article 28 of the constitution, the President of the Republic by interim is entitled to issue decrees-laws as of the date of publication of the law herein in the Official Gazette of the Republic of Tunisia, until the end of his functions, and this, in the following fields:

- general amnesty,
- human rights and public freedoms,
- electoral regime,
- press,
- organization of political parties,
- nongovernmental organizations and associations,
- fight against terrorism and repression of money laundering,
- development of the economy,
- social promotion,
- finances and taxation,
- property,
- education and culture,
- confrontation of catastrophes and risks,
- international conventions relating to the financial commitments of the State,
- international treaties of trade, taxation, economy and investment,
- international treaties relating to labor and social field,
- international treaties with link to humans rights and fundamental freedoms.

Art. 2 - The decrees-laws taken pursuant to the provisions of article one of the law herein are approved in accordance with article 28 of the constitution.

The law herein shall be published in the Official Gazette of the Republic of Tunisia and implemented as law of the State.
