

Law n° 2009-48 dated 8 July 2009, promulgating the seaports code (1).

In the name of the People,

The Chamber of Deputies and the Chamber of Advisors having adopted,

The President of the Republic enacts the following law:

Article one - The seaports code is promulgated in accordance with the law herein.

Art. 2 - The provisions of the code herein are applicable to pleasure ports within two years as from the date of its promulgation.

Art. 3 - Are repealed as from the date of entrance into force of the code herein, the commercial seaports code promulgated by law n° 99-25 dated 18 March 1999, as amended by law n° 2001-67 dated 10 July 2001 and law n° 2005-9 dated 19 January 2005 and law n° 2002-47 dated 14 May 2002 relating to fishing ports.

The decrees and orders implementing the above mentioned laws remain in force until the promulgation of the implementing texts of the code herein.

Art. 4 - The provisions relating to the real estate law provided for by the legislation on the concessions' regime is applicable to real estate rights burdening the buildings, works and fixed fittings built within the scope of concessions granted in accordance with the provisions of law n° 99-25 dated 18 March 1999 and law n° 2002-47 dated 14 May 2002, referred to in article 3 of the law herein.

The law herein shall be published in the Official Gazette of the Republic of Tunisia and implemented as law of the state.
